Update – Hogan’s Alley

Lizzie Ryan, director of Berryville Main Street, will give an update on the project at the meeting. The Tree Board remains interested in assisting.

Update – Livery Stable

The Town Council created a reserve for the costs associated (estimated at \$150,500) with stabilization of the livery stable behind 23 East Main Street. In both FY18 and FY19 the Town Council committed \$40,000 to the reserve. It is expected that \$46,500 and \$53,000 will be placed in the reserve in FY20 and FY21 respectively.
