**Preferred meter location** (if any; first come, first served):

- Install decorations between Wednesday, Nov. 25, and Monday, Nov. 30.
- Use only your assigned parking meter.
- You **MUST** cover meter head (the mechanics that accept coins) with a protective cover such as a pillowcase.
- Use waterproof materials; decorations will be in place for more than a month.
- Do not use tape, wire, adhesives, or paint on the meter head or post.
- Do not use paint or glue on the parking meter and/or the sidewalk.
- Do not attach anything you value to your parking meter.
- Decoration must not impede pedestrian traffic on the sidewalk.
- Decoration must not extend into the street or block parking spaces.

**Note:** Town of Berryville and the Berryville Main Street have the right to remove offensive or inappropriate meter decorations. Berryville and BMS are not responsible for any decorations.
